### Eligibility

Racing is open to all members and their guests. For a result to count towards series or trophy qualification a competitor must hold current membership of EPSC. All results of an individual helm will count, irrespective of boat sailed.

### Duties

Members undertaking a duty will score 3rd place for up to three duty days for each race series, excluding the pursuit series.

For the **first start only** the race officer will make a sound signal approximately 10 minutes before intended start time to indicate readiness to start. Race Officers will make reasonable adjustment to the start time to allow all members intending to race to reach the start area, taking in

(1) to account conditions, number of boats racing and experience. If significant delay anticipated formal postponement or other appropriate action should be considered.

(2) The first & last two races of the series will start at 1830
